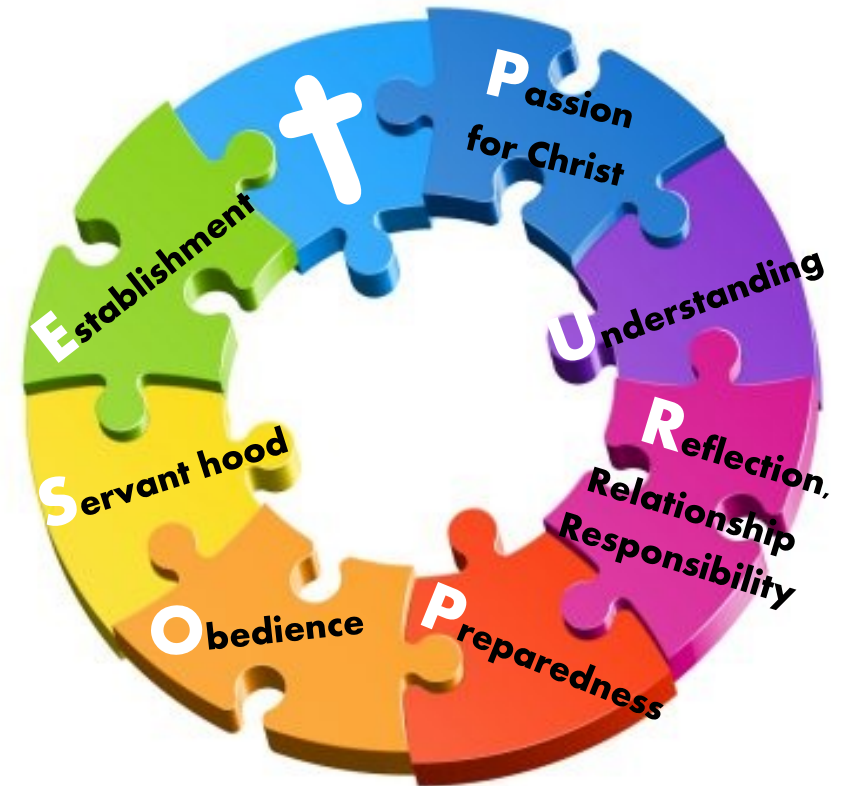

The focus for Camp in 2015 is "People of Purpose" with an emphasis on working together to accomplish what God has called us to do. We are looking at how we connect with each other thru P.U.R.P.O.S.E and importance of Teams.

What to bring:

- Tent
